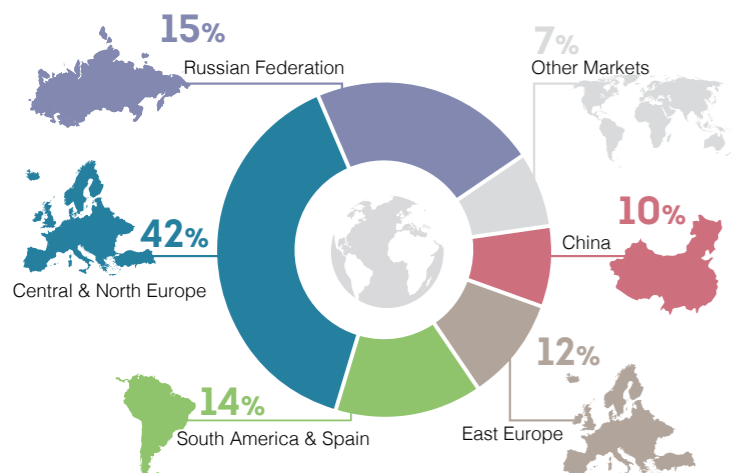

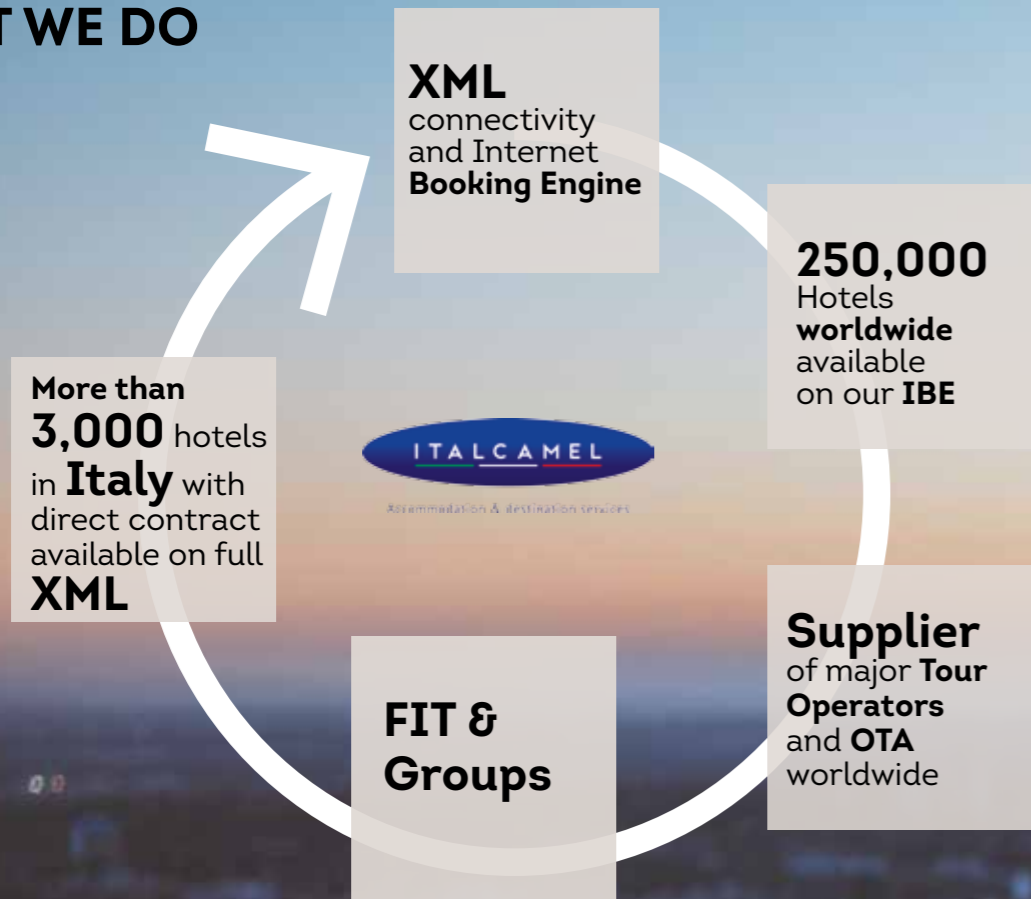

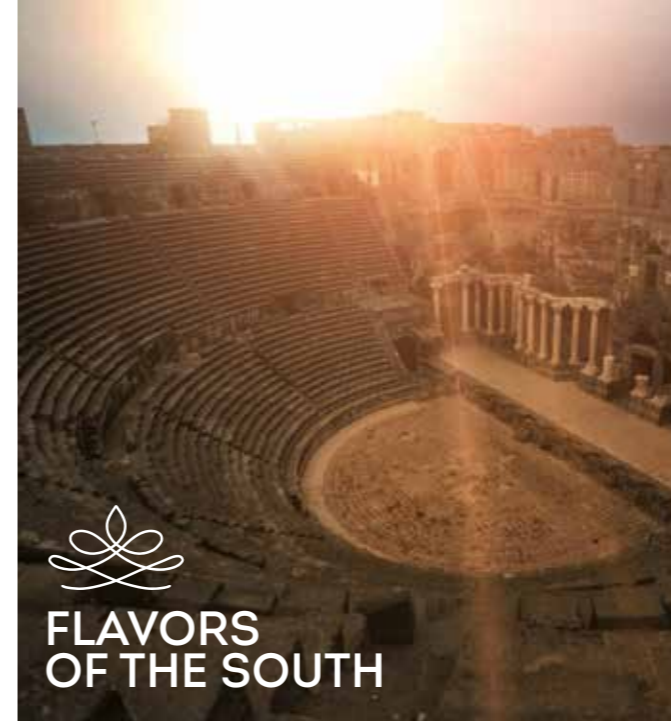

With wonderful palaces, ancient churches and basilicas, grand Roman monuments, ornate statues and graceful fountains, Rome has an immensely rich historical heritage and cosmopolitan atmosphere. Don't forget to taste its traditional dishes (*Bucatini all'amatriciana*, *Spaghetti cacio e pepe*, *Puntarelle*, *Carciofi*, *Abbacchio*) accompanied by the good wine from the Roman Castles area. "When in Rome, do as the Romans do."

After the Duomo you'll take to the streets to see some of Florence's iconic landmarks including the titanic Palazzo Vecchio, the statues of the Orsanmichele church, the Pizza della Repubblica and Piazza della Signoria, the Porcellino pig (rub his nose for good luck!) and of course, Italy's most picturesque bridge, the Ponte Vecchio.

You won't miss a masterpiece with our expert guide and carefully planned route through the huge Uffizi Gallery. Our skip the line entrance saves you time and energy for enjoying works by Da Vinci, Botticelli, Michelangelo, and other masters.

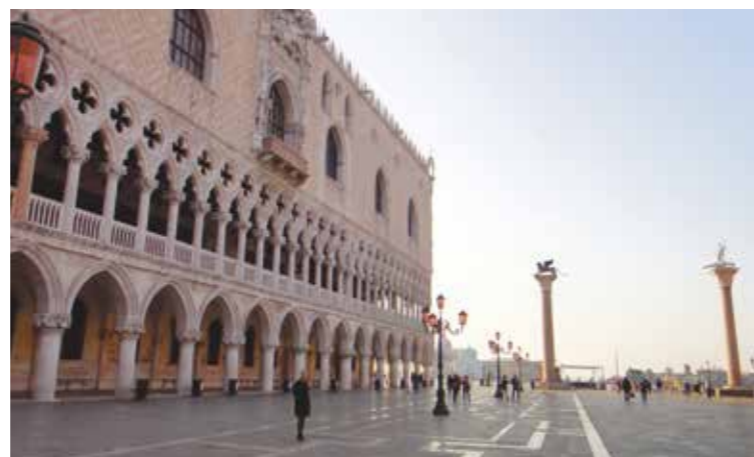

Your pizza making cooking class starts with the most important part: making the dough. After learning the art of dough making and kneeding, the chef will tell you the difference between different styles of pizza throughout Italy and Naples traditions and historic details. So you will be taught how to roll out pizza and create a vast variety of pizzas complete with different delicious toppings, with the best seasonal ingredients. While your pizzas are in the oven (a high temperature electric oven, so that it will be simple for you to recreate the pizza at home!), you can relax sipping some wine, and then taste the pizza delights you have created together for lunch.

► Tarantella Show

The Tasso Theatre will stage a Musical, lasting 75 minutes, which reconstructs our cultural roots through song and dance, with changing colourful and merry sceneries.

► Our typical Flavors

In the morning our driver will lead you to Schiazzano, a rural and small town near the city of Massa Lubrense surrounded by nature.

During the day you will visit a characteristic farm with its wonderful lemon, orange and olive groves and where the owner will be pleased to show you all the cultivation and production techniques handed down from father to son. You will taste extra virgin olive oil, limoncello and different flavored oils.

The day continues with the discovery of one of our gastronomic treasure, Mozzarella and Provolone del Monaco D.O.P. You will see all the production phases and taste this home made product in different kinds (fior di latte, caciotta, ricotta...) produced in accordance to the "Km 0" philosophy. The last step will be a traditional pizzeria in the heart of the country, where you will attend the demonstration of pizza making, and eat our special Pizza Margherita.





CINQUE TERRE

A Unesco World Heritage site since 1997, Cinque Terre means Five Lands - five ingeniously constructed fishing villages along the most dramatic coastal scenery on the planet.

Monterosso is the oldest, Riomaggiore came next, and then Vernazza, Corniglia and Manarola. Much of what remains in the villages today dates from the late High Middle Age.

EXCURSIONS AND ACTIVITIES FROM LA SPEZIA



► Extra Virgin Olive Oil mini course

Nicola is an experienced, professional olive oil sommelier and produces his olive oil on the hills between La Spezia and Cinque Terre.

He will guide you through the experience of smelling, tasting and eating olive oil on a varieties of "bruschetta" to understand which oil goes on which food and with which wine.

► Liguria Fish Cooking lesson & Visit to the Market

A full culinary experience starts with the visit to its typical market: see the fish sellers with the fresh fish and seafood, find the regional and seasonal vegetables. With your cook, you buy the things you will need to prepare your lunch. After the market visit in the morning, you reach the nice little restaurant where this beautiful lesson takes place.

► Sailing along the Cinque Terre Coast

In La Spezia harbour you will go on board and cross first the Gulf of Poets seeing the beautiful villages of Portovenere and Lerici and the islands Palmaria and Tino. Later you will sail along the Cinque Terre coast enjoying great views of the villages. You will stop in a nice place i.e. in front of Vernazza and have a light lunch with local specialities like focaccia and anchovies. A stop for swimming in the wonderful marine protection area is planned too.

(Who does not only like to relax will have the possibility to learn from our experienced English-speaking skipper the basics of sailing).

ACTIVITIES FROM THE CINQUE TERRE VILLAGES



► From Manarola: wine experience

Discover the viticulture traditions of Manarola with Alessandro, a young winemaker native of this beautiful village of Cinque Terre.

You will leave the centre of Manarola and walking through the main road leading to the small harbour where you will have the opportunity to admire the typical colorful houses and the fishing boats. Then you will go up to the cemetery which is located in a fantastic panoramic position from which you can appreciate Manarola and even a partial view of Corniglia. Through an ancient path in the midst of gardens, you will reach the vineyards of Alessandro where he will teach you to distinguish the grape varieties and the different methods of pruning and grape growing. The path leads you in front of the Church of San Lorenzo and with an extra effort you will go to Alessandro's wine cellar where you will taste his white wine Cinque Terre DOC accompanied by the typical Ligurian focaccia.

Alessandro is also a member of the Foundation of Manarola Cinque Terre, created in 2014 in order to protect the cultural heritage of the village. With your participation to the tour you support the project of the Foundation with a little charity.

► From Manarola: pesto course

In a strategic and unforgettable location was born this new bar with breathtaking view, run by two young guys. The pesto course will take life here, starting from the basil harvest in their own vegetable garden and by picking the ingredients. Simone will show you how to make the traditional pesto sauce, with the use of the mortar, explaining its ingredients and history.

You will enjoy making pesto surrounded by wonderful places, colours and perfumes.

At the end, you will taste your pesto on a bruschetta (toasted bread) together with a glass of Cinque Terre wine.

► From Manarola: wine tasting in an ancient wine cellar

One of the best places to taste our local wines is an ancient wine cellar. The one where we would like to welcome you is located in the centre of Manarola, near the little harbour. It has been completely renovated and is now a Bar-Enoteca, a wonderful place where people meet, drink wine, enjoy good music and some food. You will have a tasting of Cinque Terre white wine DOC, a tasting of a red wine IGT produced in Cinque Terre and a tasting of the famous Sciacchetra, our sweet wine. With the tastings you will eat some local snacks.

► From Riomaggiore: wine tasting in scenic location

We invite you to a wine tasting of our Cinque Terre wines in an incredible location: a trendy wine-bar at the beginning of the famous Via dell'Amore, high on the cliffs over the sea with a great panoramic view. The owner Yvonne, a sommelieuse, will introduce you the wines of Cinque Terre, offering four wines of different winegrowers. The tasting will be accompanied by some local snacks like focaccia bread, olives, pesto or the typical rice or vegetable cake. Enjoy the unique atmosphere of the place relaxing in late afternoon, overlooking the sea and the coloured houses of Riomaggiore.



► From Monterosso: Wine Tasting

In Monterosso we would like to offer you a tasting of wines from winemakers located in Monterosso. You will taste a Cinque Terre DOC white wine, a naturally and traditionally made local white wine and a Sciacchetra. During this tasting we want to show you how in a limited area like Cinque Terre, completely different wines and philosophies of winemaking can develop. You will learn more about the new generation of Cinque Terre wine makers and the renaissance of traditional wine making. The tasting will be accompanied by some *crostini* and some *cantucci* with the Sciacchetra.

► From Levanto: cooking class

You will meet Ermanno, one of the best Levanto's Chefs. He will introduce you to his beautiful restaurant and its lovely kitchen before starting the cooking lesson.

The Italian cuisine is famous for involving a generous use of herbs in most of the recipes, such as rosemary, thyme, sage, borage and fresh basil. Day trip to Verona and visit to the city center with English-speaking guide.

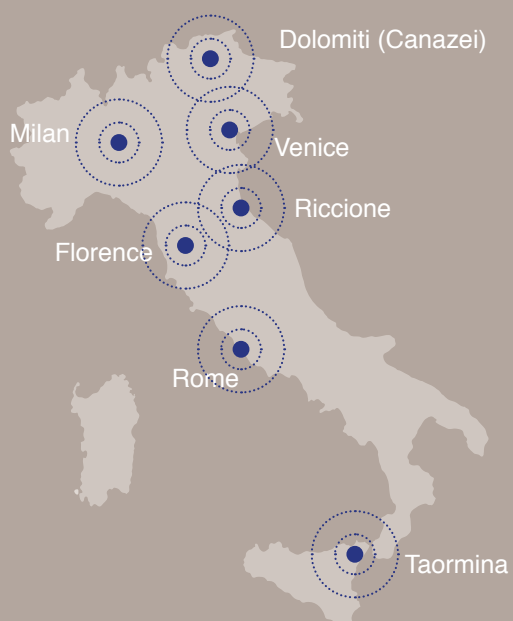
